



The main objective of the workshop is to improve the knowledge of students about Manufacturing, Quality Assurance and Quality Control in the field of Pharmacy.

While speaking to the gathering Prof. Sayanna advised to carry out the practicals since its very important to Pharmacy education. He asked the teachers to impart knowledge to the students during lab hours. He explained how the globalization and development is causing pollution resulting in ill health of the public. At this juncture, the role of Pharmacist is very important, Prof. Sayanna said. He appreciated for conducting such workshops and suggested students to come up with ideas and research for developing rural areas and drugs to be available at affordable price with good quality.

Prof. M Sarangapani, Dean, Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Kakatiya University has elaborated the importance of the work shop in improving the skills. He remembered former Prime Minister Sri P V Narasimha Rao who paved the way in improving the Human Resource Development in the field of education. He also spoke about Nano Technology in Pharmacy, targeted drug delivery system etc. Dr. Ashutosh Dixit, who has over 30 years of industrial experience in QA in leading pharma companies, while starting the workshop he explained about Quality Assurance, Current Good Manufacturing Practices, Deviation and Change Control Management, Market Complaint Handling and Product Development and Drug Design.

Dr. Dixit said the Pharma industry never dies as the growth of Pharma Industry was estimated to be 2.13 to 2.25 billion dollars between 2014-2025. The manpower resource has become very important in the industry. He said, India is in the third place in terms of volume in production, Globally India stands 1.4% of total production Having 14th largest buying value and there are around 3000 Pharma Companies are existed all over India and 10500 manufacturing units are currently in operation. Among these 1300 are recognized by World Health Organization Good Manufacturing Practices (WHOGMP). About 950 companies are under Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA) which is an Australian Drug Regulatory Body.

Also, Dr. Dixit in his workshop explained about ICH (International Conference for Harmonization) guidelines for current good manufacturing practices.

Dr. Rajashekar, Principal and Mr. T. Jayapal Reddy, Chairman, St. Peter's Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences have taken part of the program and such workshops will be conducted every now and then in order to improve the skills and knowledge of the students. Sri Jayapal Reddy thanked the University authorities for their cooperation in conducting workshops and remembered the value of Pharmacy Education under Kakatiya University.
