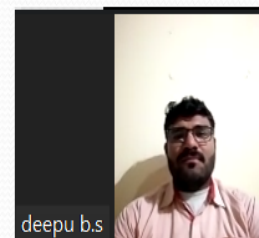


WEBINAR ON INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

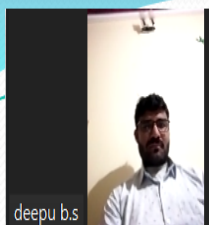

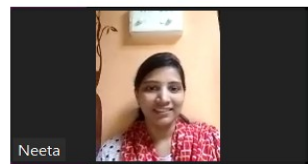

Deficiency of various vitamins like vitamin D,B-12, Calcium and Iron. she stated that some studies found that Vitamin deficient people were more likely to be infected with covid. she also stated that vitamin deficiency people may serve as a mitigating effect for covid-19 infection, severity and mortality. She also recommended students to eat vitamin rich fruits and vegetables and vitamin supplements.
