- Increase awareness among pharmacy students and faculty members about the importance of mental health and its impact on overall well-being.



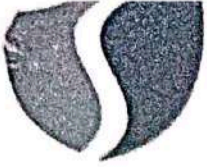

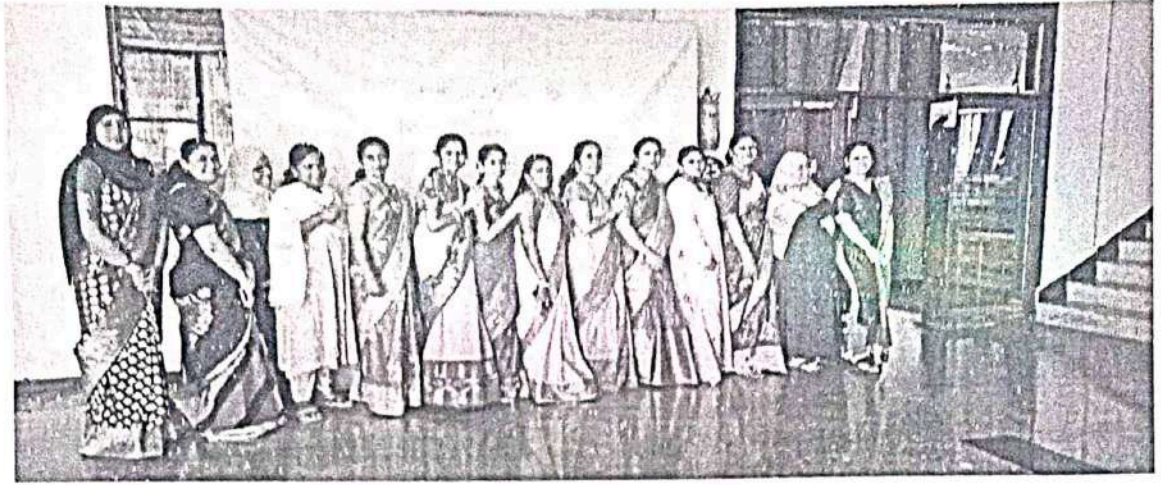
