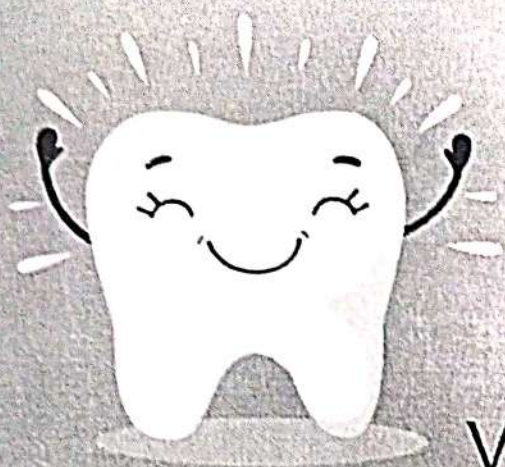

- Inspire participants to adopt lifelong habits of good oral hygiene and to prioritize oral health as an integral part of their personal wellness routines and professional responsibilities.

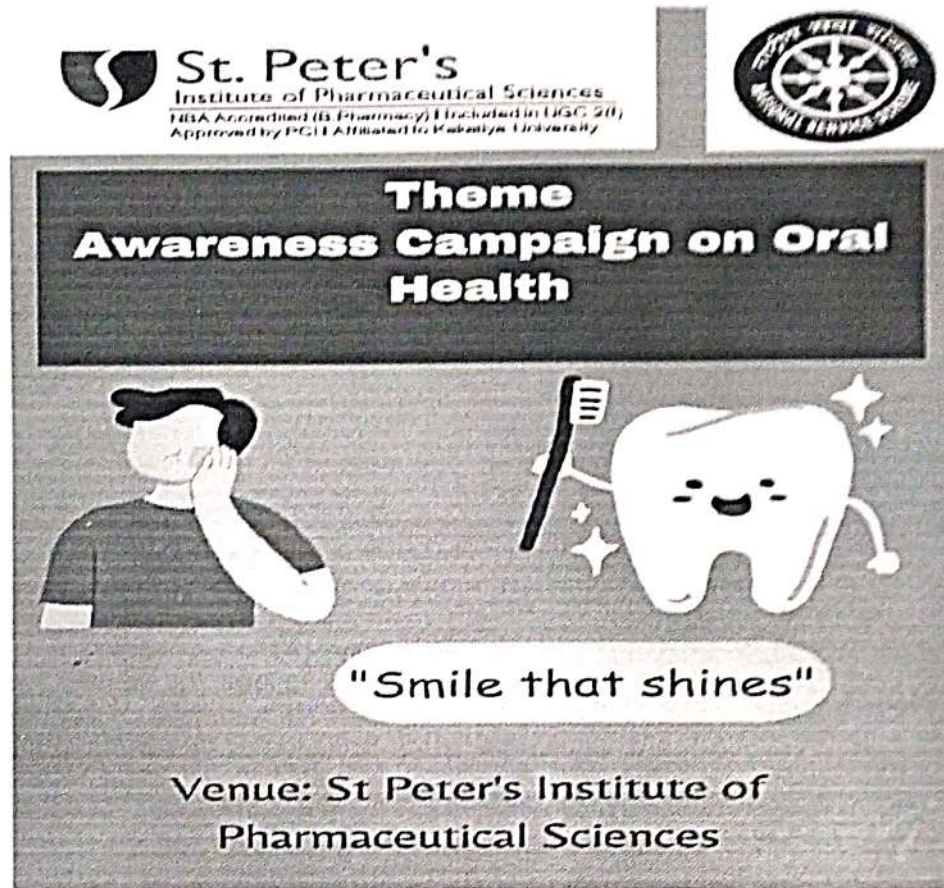
